VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

For the 2016 general election, **identification will be asked of you and can include:**

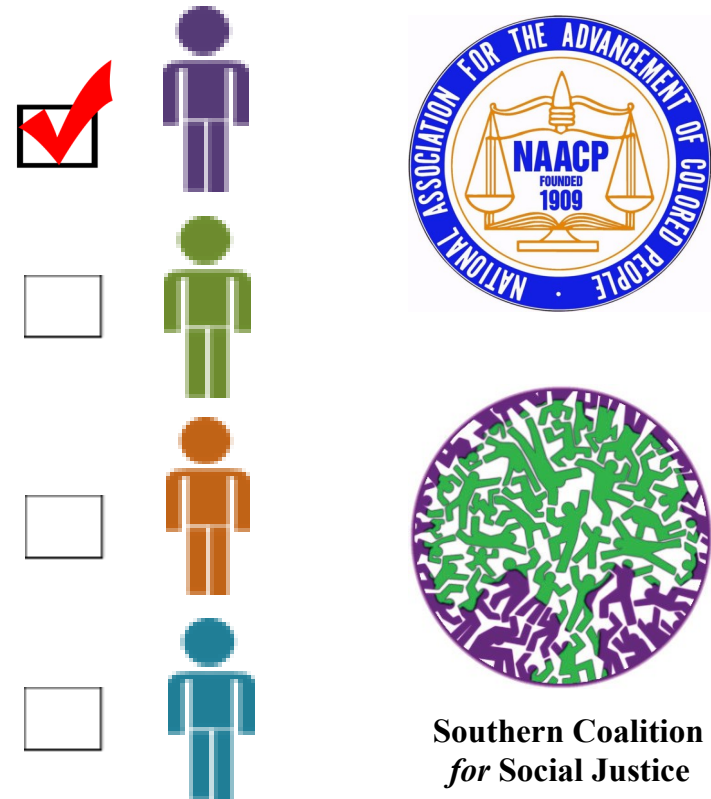
- Voter ID card, driver's license, state ID card, or military ID card
- Any current or valid photo identification
- Passport or other government-issued document
- Hunting or fishing license
- Current Utility bill
- Government Paycheck or bank statement

If you do not have identification or your name does not appear on the precinct register, you must vote a questioned ballot.

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election, make sure you are **registered by Sunday, October 9, 2016**. Alaska law provides for **same day voter registration for the purpose of voting for President and Vice President**.

REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Alaska, you must:

- Be a United States citizen;
- Be an Alaska resident;
- Be at least 18 years old or within 90 days of your 18th birthday;
- Not be a convicted felon, unless your voting rights have been restored; and
- Not be registered to vote in another state unless willing to cancel your registration in the other state.

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, you must provide **proof of unconditional discharge and reregister**. Crimes involving moral turpitude are ineligible.

Early voting dates for the general election are **October 24 - Election Day**.
