VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

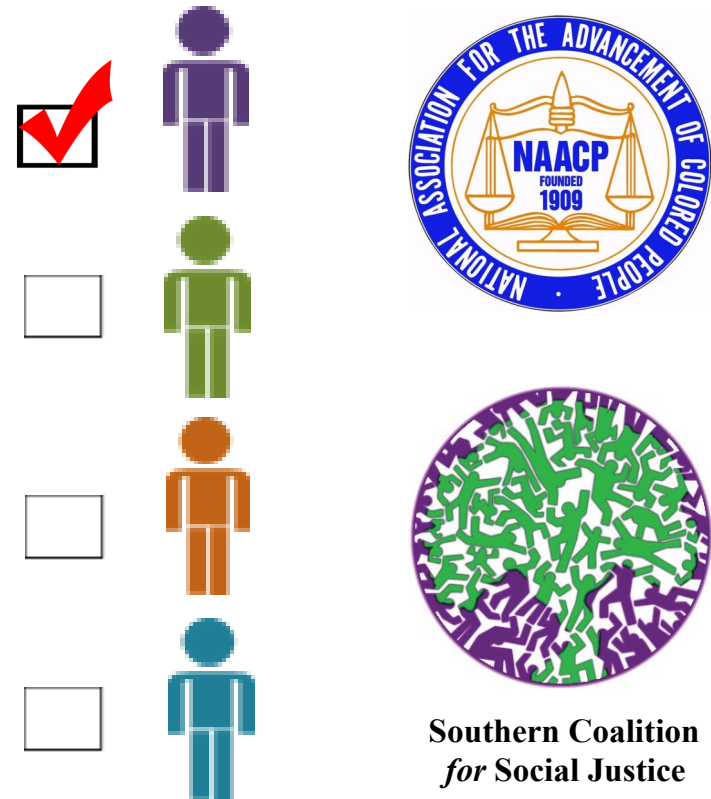
For the 2016 general election, a valid form of **photo identification (ID)** is required. Acceptable forms of photo ID include:

- Valid AL Driver's License
- Valid Alabama Nondriver ID
- Valid free Alabama Photo Voter ID card
- Any valid State issued ID
- Valid Federal issued ID
- Valid US passport
- Valid Military ID
- Valid Tribal ID
- Valid student or employee ID from any college or university in Alabama, or state institution of higher learning in any other state
- Valid Employee ID (Federal, State, County, Municipality, Board, or other entity of the state)

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election, make sure you are **registered by October 24, 2016**.

Citizens may register to vote all year, except during the fourteen days prior to an election and on election day.

REQUIREMENTS

Any person may register to vote, provided that he or she:

- is a citizen of the United States;
- resides in Alabama;
- is at least 18 years old on or before election day;
- has not been barred from voting due to a disqualifying felony conviction;
- and has not been declared mentally incompetent by a court.

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, individuals may apply for a “Certificate of Eligibility” if all terms of the sentence have been fulfilled. Contact the Alabama Board of Pardons and Paroles, or <http://pardons.state.al.us/>

EARLY VOTING DATES

Alabama does not offer early voting.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

A voter may cast an absentee ballot under the following conditions:

- Out of county on Election Day
- Illness or disability
- Registered but living outside of the county
- Being an appointed election officer/poll watcher
- Working a required shift (10 hours or more) that coincides with polling hours.

All absentee ballots must be **requested by Thursday, November 3, 2016** (five days before Election Day).

All absentee ballots must be **postmarked by Monday, November 7, 2016** (the day before Election Day).
