VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

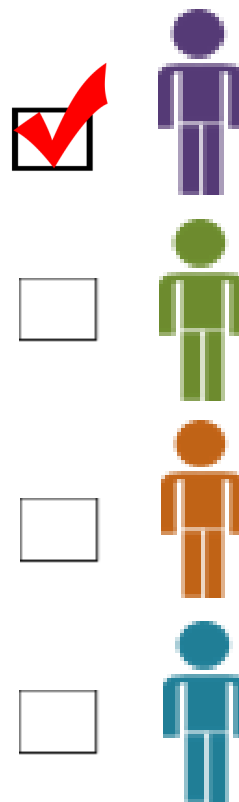
For the 2016 general election, **registered voters do not have to show ID to vote.** First-time voters who registered by mail, and did not provide proof of residence when registering will need to show proof of residence in order to cast a regular ballot.

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election, make sure you are **registered by email or regular mail postmarked by Tuesday, October 11, 2016** (no later than 30 days prior to Election Day). After that date you can only **register to vote in person. There is no registration deadline in person, you may register and cast a special ballot on Election Day.** Visit www.dcboee.org for details.

REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in DC, you must be:

- a U.S. citizen,
- a resident of DC,
- at least 18 years old by the next general election and not registered in any other county or state,
- not found by a court to be legally incompetent to vote

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, your right to vote will be restored after your term of incarceration and after completion of your parole or probation.

EARLY VOTING DATES

Early voting dates for the general election are **Saturday, October 29 - Saturday, November 5, 2016.**

EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS

Contact your local county board of elections by phone or visit them online for early voting locations.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

All registered voters in DC may request and mail in an absentee ballot without an excuse.

- Must be **requested by November 1, 2016**
(Requested seven days before Election Day.)
- Must be **received by 8:00 pm Election Day.**
