VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

For the 2016 general election, **you will be asked to show identification (ID)**. Acceptable forms of ID include: any valid photo ID, utility bill, paycheck or any other government document featuring your name and address.

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election, make sure you are **registered by Sunday, October 15, 2016.**

There is no same-day or Election Day registration.

REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Delaware, you must be:

- a U.S. citizen
- a resident of Delaware
- at least 18 years old by the next general election (or within 90 days) and not registered in any other county or state.
- Not adjudged mentally incompetent

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, your right to vote will be restored after your term of incarceration and after completion of your parole or probation, and fines. Visit elections.delaware.gov for more information.

EARLY VOTING DATES

There is no early voting Delaware.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Voters may request and mail an absentee ballot only with an acceptable excuse. Acceptable excuses include:

- Business or occupation prevents you from coming to the polls (including students)
- Vacation/out of town on Election Day
- The tenets or teachings of your religion prevent you from coming to the polls
- Temporary or permanent physical disability
- Public service of the United States or the State of Delaware and are unable to come to the polls

Request your absentee ballot as early as possible to ensure it is **received by 8:00 pm Election Day.**
