VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

For the 2016 general election, a valid form of **photo identification (ID)** is required. Acceptable forms of photo ID include:

- Any valid state or federal government issued photo ID, including a free ID Card issued by your county registrar's office or the Georgia Department of Driver Services (DDS),
- A Georgia Driver's License, even if expired,
- Valid employee photo ID from any branch, department, agency, or entity of the U.S. Government, Georgia, or any county, municipality, board, authority or other entity of this state,
- Valid U.S. passport ID,
- Valid U.S. military photo ID,
- Valid tribal photo ID

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election, make sure you are **registered by Tuesday, October 11, 2016.**

There is neither same-day registration nor Election Day registration.

REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Georgia, you must be:

- a U.S. citizen
- a resident of a Georgia county
- at least 18 years old by the next general election, and not registered in any other county or state
- not been found mentally incompetent by a judge

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, your right to vote will be restored after your term of incarceration and after completion of your parole or probation. For more details visit www.sos.georgia.gov.

EARLY VOTING DATES

Early voting dates for the general election are **Monday, October 17 - Friday, November 4, 2016.**

EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS

Contact your local county board of elections by phone or visit them online for early voting locations

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

All registered voters in Georgia may request and mail in an absentee ballot without an excuse.

- Must be **mailed to voter before Monday, November 7, 2016** (please allow sufficient time for request and ballot)
- Must be **received by 7:00 pm on Election Day**
