VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

For the 2016 general election, an **acceptable form of identification (ID) is required**. Acceptable forms of ID include:

- a valid photo ID (Drivers License, State ID, etc.),
- a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, or other government issued document that shows your name and address.

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election, make sure you are **registered by Monday October 10, 2016.**

There is neither same-day registration nor Election Day registration.

REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Hawaii, you must be:

- a U.S. citizen
- a resident of the State of Hawaii (residence acquired with the intent to make Hawaii the person's legal residence)

Hawaii law allows qualified individuals to pre-register at sixteen (16) years of age. Upon reaching eighteen (18) years of age, they will be automatically registered.

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, your right to vote will be restored after your term of incarceration. For more details visit **elections.hawaii.gov/**.

EARLY VOTING DATES

Early voting dates for the general election are **Tuesday, October 25 - Saturday, November 5, 2016.**

EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS

Contact your local county board of elections by phone or visit them online for early voting locations

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Any registered voter may request a mail ballot or cast their vote at an early walk-in location within their county without an excuse.

- Must be **requested by Tuesday, November 1, 2016** (please allow sufficient time for request and ballot)
- Must be **received by 6:00 pm on Election Day**
