VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

For the 2016 general election, an **acceptable form of photo identification (ID) is required**. Acceptable forms of photo ID include:

- An Idaho driver's license or Idaho photo identification card
- A U.S. passport or Federal photo identification card
- A tribal photo identification card
- A current student photo ID, issued by an Idaho high school or post secondary education institution

If a voter does not have an Idaho Driver's License, they can use an Idaho photo identification card issued by the Department of Transportation to vote.

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election, make sure you are **registered by Friday, October 14, 2016** (25 days prior to Election Day). Idaho also provides for **Election Day registration**. To register on Election Day, bring a document with a valid address in your precinct and photo identification when you go to your polling place.

REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Idaho, you must be:

- at least 18 years old on Election Day
- a citizen of the United States, and;
have resided in Idaho and in the county for 30 days

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, your right to vote will be automatically restored upon completion of your sentence, including any probation or parole. For more details visit www.idahovotes.gov/.

EARLY VOTING DATES

Early voting dates for the general election are **Monday, October 24 - Friday, November 4**.

EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS

Contact your local county board of elections by phone or visit them online for early voting locations

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Any registered voter may can vote by absentee ballot and return their ballot by mail or personal delivery.

- Must be **requested by Wednesday, November 2, 2016** (please allow sufficient time for request and ballot)
- Must be **received by 8:00 pm on Election Day**
