VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

For the 2016 general election, a valid form of **photo identification (ID) is required**. Your photo ID must meet 4 criteria to be acceptable for voting purposes. It must:

1. Display your photo.
2. Display your name, and the name must conform to your voter registration record.
3. Display an expiration date and either be current or have expired sometime after the date of the last General Election (November 4, 2014).
4. Be issued by the State of Indiana or the U.S. government.

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election, make sure you are **registered by Tuesday, October 11, 2016.**

There is neither same-day registration nor Election Day registration.

REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Indiana, you must be:

- be a citizen of the United States,
- be at least 18 years old on the day of the next general, municipal, or special election,
- have lived in your precinct for at least 30 days before the next general, municipal, or special election (except for certain military voters)

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, your right to vote will be restored after your term of incarceration. For more details visit www.in.gov/sos/elections/.

EARLY VOTING DATES

Any registered voter may vote an **absentee-in-person ballot starting Tuesday, October 11, 2016** at locations designated by your county's election board. Contact your local county board of elections by phone or visit them online for early voting locations. Contact information for all 92 county election offices can be found at www.IndianaVoters.com.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

All registered voters in Indiana may request an absentee-in-person ballot without an excuse. Certain conditions apply for absentee-by-mail.

- Absentee-by-mail ballot application must be received by **Monday, Monday, October 31, 2016** (please allow sufficient time for request and ballot)
- Absentee-in-person ballot must be **received by noon Monday, November 7, 2016.**
