## VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

For the 2016 general election, **you are required to provide government-issued photo identification (ID) to vote in person and by mail.** Acceptable forms of ID include: driver's license, state ID card, concealed carry handgun license, U.S. passport, government employee ID, U.S. military ID, student ID from a Kansas college or university, government public assistance ID or tribal ID. **Visit [www.gotvoterid.com](http://www.gotvoterid.com) for more information.**

# VOTER REGISTRATION

# EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

## REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election, make sure your **mail-in registration is postmarked by Tuesday, October 18, 2016** (21 days before Election Day).

## REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Kansas, you must be:

- a U.S. citizen
- a resident of Kansas for at least 21 days
- at least 18 years old by the next general election

(or within 90 days) and not registered in any other county or state.

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, your voting rights are restored and you may register to vote when your terms of incarceration, probation and parole are complete. **Visit [www.voteks.org/](http://www.voteks.org/)** for more information about registering to vote.

## EARLY VOTING DATES

With advance voting, any registered voter can vote by mail or in person before election day. Advance voting dates are **Wednesday, October 19, 2016—Election Day**.

## LOCATIONS

Contact your local county office by phone or visit them online for early/advance voting times and locations.

## ABSENTEE BALLOTS

All registered voters in Kansas may request and mail in an advance voting ballot without an excuse.

- Must be **requested by Friday, November 4, 2016** (four days before Election Day).
- Must be **received by 7:00 pm on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2016**.
