

VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

For the 2016 general election, **you will be asked for a form of identification (ID) when you vote.** Acceptable forms of ID include: *identification issued by the state of Missouri, agency, or a local election authority; U.S. government ID; identification issued by an institution of higher education located within the state of Missouri; copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check or other government document that contains the name and address of the voter; driver's license or state identification card issued by another state.* If you do not possess any of these, you may still cast a ballot if two supervising election judges, attest they know you.

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election, make sure **your mail-in registration is postmarked by October 12, 2016.**

REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Missouri, you must be:

- a U.S. citizen
- a resident of Missouri
- at least 18 years old, 17 1/2 years of age to register

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, you may register to vote after you complete your terms of incarceration, including probation and parole. Visit www.sos.mo.gov/elections/goVoteMissouri/howtovote for more information about registering to vote.

EARLY VOTING DATES

There is no early voting in Missouri.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

All registered voters in Missouri may request an absentee ballot, but only with an excuse. Acceptable excuses include:

- absence from the jurisdiction,
- illness or physical disability,
- Religious belief or practice,
- Employment as an election authority at a location other than your polling place, and
- Incarceration, provided all qualifications for voting are retained.

Ballots **must be requested by November 7, 2016, or 5:00pm on November 2, 2016** if requesting a ballot by mail. All ballots **must be received by close of polls on Election Day.** Visit www.sos.mo.gov/elections/goVoteMissouri/howtovote for more information about absentee voting.
