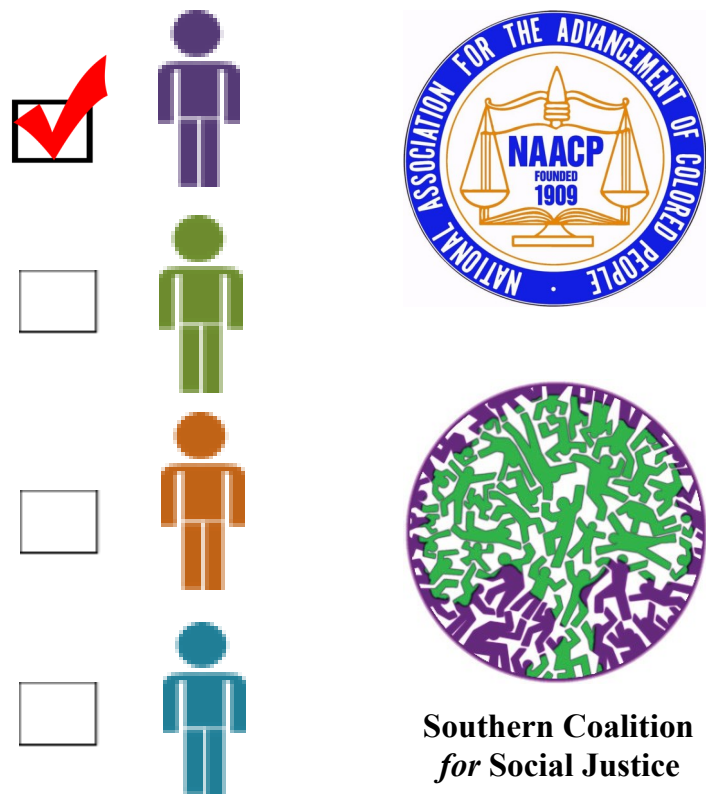
# 2016 VOTER GUIDE

## VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

For the 2016 general election, a valid form of **photo identification (ID) is required**. A current photo ID showing the elector's name; or a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, voter registration confirmation, government check or other government document showing the elector's current name and current address must be presented. If you do not have any of the items listed above, you can still vote by requesting and filling out a "Polling Place Elector ID" form, or vote a provisional ballot.

# EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

## REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election, make sure you are:

- **registered by 5:00 p.m. October 11, 2016.**

Individuals can **late-register at the county election office beginning October 12, 2016 and through close of polls on election day.**

## REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Montana, you must:

- Be registered as required by law,
- Be 18 years old or older on or before the next election,
- Be a citizen of the United States,
- Have lived in Montana for at least 30 days.

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, your right to vote will be restored after your term of incarceration.

## EARLY VOTING DATES

Montana does not offer early voting.

## ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Any registered voter may vote by absentee ballot.

Absentee ballots are mailed to eligible voters **beginning Friday, October 14, 2016.** An application may be mailed, or dropped off at the county election office.

- Applications must be received by the county election office by **noon November 7, 2016.**
- Absentee ballots must be received at the election office or polling place by **8:00 p.m. on Election Day.**
