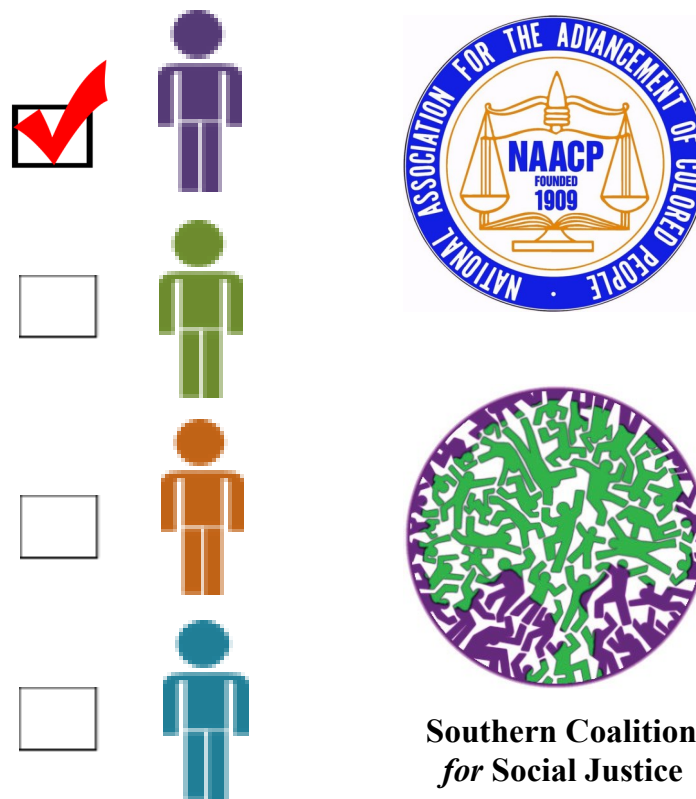
VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

For the 2016 general election, a **valid form of photo identification (ID) is required**. Acceptable forms of photo ID include: *driver's license issued by any state or federal government; non-driver ID card issued by NH DMV or motor vehicle agency of another state; photo ID card for "voting identification only" issued by NH DMV; US armed services identification card; US passport or passcard; NH student ID card.*

Any voter who does not present an approved photo ID will be permitted to vote after executing a challenged voter affidavit.

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election:

- Last day to register until Election Day is **October 29, 2016**.
- Unregistered voters may register and vote **on Election Day**.

REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in New Hampshire, you must be:

- a U.S. citizen,
- a resident of New Hampshire,
- at least 18 years old.

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, you may register to vote after you complete your terms of incarceration.

You can vote while on probation and parole. Visit <http://sos.nh.gov/Felons.aspx> for more information about registering to vote.

EARLY VOTING DATES

There is no early voting in New Hampshire.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

In order to request and mail in an absentee ballot in New Hampshire, you must declare one of the following:

- physical disability,
- religious beliefs,
- military service, or
- temporary absence.

Absentee ballots must be received:

- in person by 5:00 pm on November 7, 2016,
- by mail, 5:00pm on Election Day.
