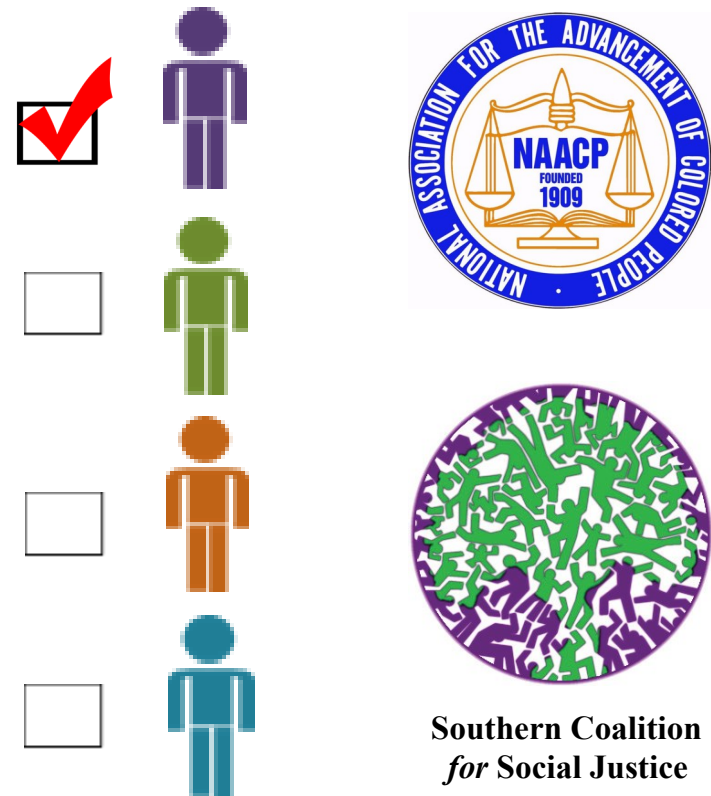
## VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

To vote in the 2016 general election, **you will be required to show some form of identification (ID). Acceptable forms of ID include current and valid:** *Nevada Driver's license; Nevada Identification Card; Armed Forces Identification Card, Sheriff's Work Identification Card; Identification Card issued by an Agency of the State of Nevada, or other political subdivision; Student Identification Card; United States Passport; Tribal Identification Card.* Other forms of identification may be used, please check with your County Clerk/ Registrar of Voters for other acceptable forms of identification.

# VOTER REGISTRATION

# EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

## REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election:

- Make sure your mail-in registration is postmarked by **October 8, 2016**.
- Make sure you are registered in person or online **October 9– October 18, 2016**.

## REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Nevada, you must be:

- a U.S. citizen,
- a resident of Nevada for 30 days preceding an election,
- at least 18 years old

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, your right to vote is immediately restored after you have been discharged honorably from incarceration, probation, and parole.

## EARLY VOTING DATES

Early voting dates for the general election are **Saturday, October 22 - Friday, November 4, 2016**.

## LOCATIONS

Voters can vote at any location in their respective county where early voting is offered. Please contact your county election office for more information.

## ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Any registered voter may request to vote an absentee ballot by mail.

- Must be requested by **5:00 pm on November 1, 2016** (seven days before Election Day).
- Must be received by **7:00pm on Election Day**.

Requests should be submitted as early as possible to allow enough time to ensure your absent ballot is received by your County Clerk/Registrar's office.
