VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

In order to vote in person, a **voter must announce his or her full name and current address and provide proof of identity with voter's name and current address.** Acceptable forms of ID include: *unexpired Ohio driver's license or state identification card; military identification; photo identification that was issued by the United States government or the State of Ohio, that contains the expiration date that has not passed; current utility bill; current bank statement; current government check; current paycheck; or current other government document (other than a notice of voter registration mailed by a board of elections).*

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election, make sure you are **registered by Tuesday, October 11, 2016** (at least 30 days prior to Election Day).

REQUIREMENTS

To vote in Ohio, a person must be:

- A United States citizen;
- At least 18 years old on the day of the election;
- A resident of Ohio for at least 30 days preceding the election.

If you have **been convicted of a felony**, your voting rights are restored after release from prison. You may also vote while on probation, or parole. Visit www.sos.state.oh.us/ for more details.

EARLY VOTING DATES

In Ohio, voters have many options to vote. Starting the day after the close of voter registration, all registered voters may request and vote an absentee ballot in person.

LOCATIONS

Contact your local county board of elections for more information.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

All registered voters in Ohio may request and mail in an absentee ballot without an excuse.

- Must be **requested by Saturday, November 5, 2016** (three days before Election Day).
- Must be **received by the close of polls on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2016.**
