

VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

You must show proof of identification (ID) that includes your name and address only if you are a first-time voter. Approved forms of ID include: *Pennsylvania driver's license or PennDOT ID card, ID issued by any Commonwealth agency, ID issued by the U.S. government, U.S. Passport, military ID, student ID, employee ID, U.S. Armed Forces ID, confirmation issued by the County Voter Registration Office, firearm permit, current utility bill, bank statement, current paycheck, or government check.*

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

You must be registered by **Tuesday, October 11, 2016** to vote in the upcoming election. There is neither same-day registration nor Election Day registration.

REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Pennsylvania you must be:

- a U.S. citizen for at least one month,
- a resident of Pennsylvania and their election district for at least 30 days,
- at least 18 years old.

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, your voting rights are restored when your terms of incarceration are complete (upon release) and you may then register to vote. You are eligible to register to vote while on probation or parole. Visit www.votespa.com for more details.

EARLY VOTING DATES

Pennsylvania does not have early voting.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Pennsylvania voters may request and mail an absentee ballot with an acceptable excuse. Excuses include:

- A member of the military or Merchant Marines, or a spouse or dependent,
- A member of a religious or welfare group serving with the military,
- Work or elector's duties (including leaves of absence and vacation) that coincide with election,
- Illness or physical disability,
- A county employee with Election Day duties,
- Observance of a religious holiday.

Absentee ballots must be **requested by 5:00 pm on Tuesday, November 1, 2016**, and must be received by **5:00 pm on Friday, November 4, 2016**. Visit www.votespa.com for details.
