

Dr. W. Montague Cobb Award

Upon recommendation of the NAACP National Health Committee and approval of the NAACP National Board, the Montague Cobb Health Advocacy award was established to honor individuals and organizations that have made a significant impact in the field of health. This award shall be given annually in recognition of the legacy of Dr. W. Montague Cobb, who served as the President of the NAACP from 1976 to 1983.

National

The Dr. W. Montague Cobb Award is presented annually to an outstanding individual or organization by the NAACP National Health Committee, in recognition nationally of special achievement in Social Justice, Health Justice, Health Education, Health Promotion, Fundraising and Research. This Award will be presented to a selected recipient each year at the Annual NAACP Convention.

State

The Dr. W. Montague Cobb Award is presented annually to the State Conference Health Committee Chair by the NAACP National Health Committee, for outstanding work and in recognition of statewide special achievement in the areas of Social Justice, Health Justice Advocacy, Health Education, Health Promotion, Fundraising, and Research. This Award will be presented to a selected recipient each year at the Annual NAACP Convention.

Individual

The Dr. W. Montague Cobb Award is presented annually by the NAACP National Health Committee, to an outstanding individual in a local community in recognition of special achievement in areas of Social Justice, Health Justice Advocacy, Health Education, Health Promotion, Fund Raising, and Research. This person should be a “grassroots advocate,” focusing on community programming at the local level. This Award will be presented to a selected recipient each year at the Annual NAACP Convention.
