

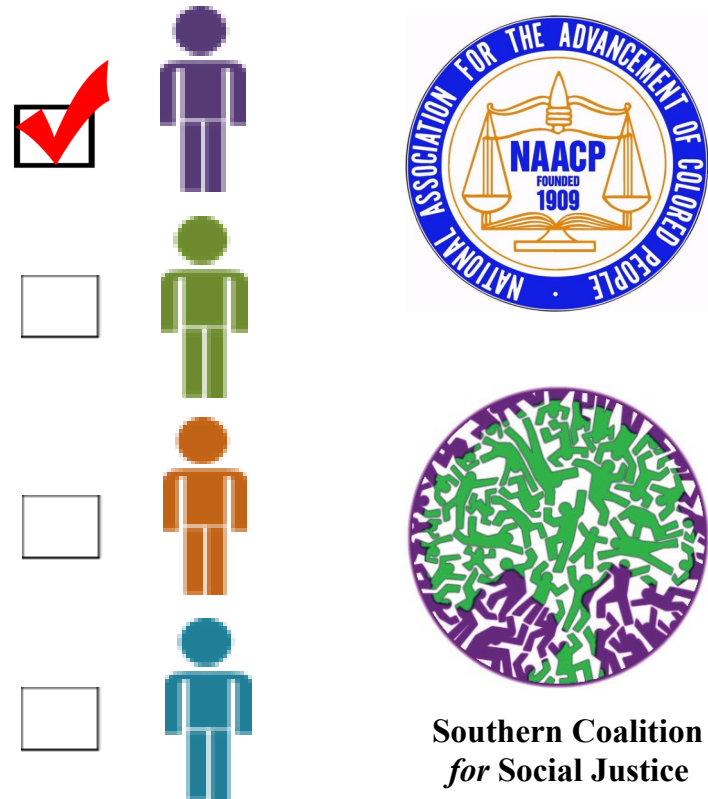

VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

For the 2016 general election, **you will be asked to provide a valid photo identification (ID) with signature.**

The following photo IDs will be accepted: driver's license, ID card issued by the DMV, US passport, debit or credit card, Military ID, student ID, retirement center ID, neighborhood association ID, or public assistance ID. If you do not have the proper ID, you can still vote with provisional ballot that will count if the signature on the provisional ballot envelope matches the signature on your voter registration application.

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming election, make sure you are **registered by October 11, 2016** (at least 29 days prior to Election Day).

REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Florida, you must be:

- a U.S. citizen
- a resident of Florida
- at least 18 years old by the next general election and not registered in any other county or state
- not have been adjudicated mentally incapacitated

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, you have to apply for executive clemency after a five-year waiting period. Certain offenses require a seven-year waiting period and a hearing to restore voting rights. For more information visit www.dc.state.fl.us/restoration.html.

EARLY VOTING

Early voting dates for the general election are **Saturday, October 29 - Saturday, November 5, 2016.**

EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS

Contact your local county board of elections by phone or visit them online for early voting locations.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

All registered voters in Florida may request and mail in an absentee ballot without an excuse.

- Must be **requested by November 2, 2016** (Requested six days before Election Day, but can be picked up until and including on Election Day)
- Must be **received by 7:00 pm Election Day.**
