VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

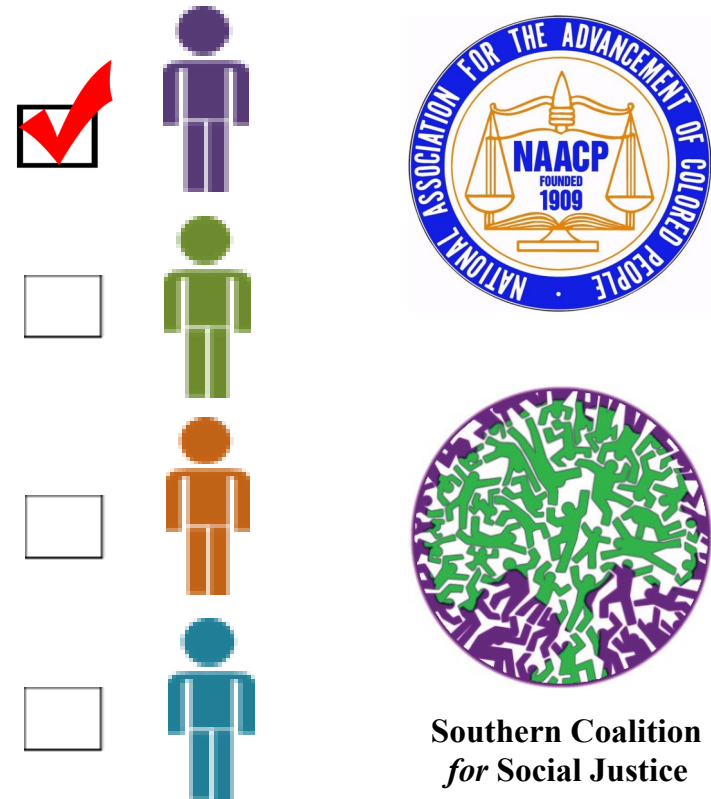
To vote in the 2016 general election, **you will be required to identify yourself** by showing one of the following:

- driver's license;
- Louisiana Special ID; or
- some other generally recognized picture ID that contains your name and signature.

If you do not have a driver's license, Louisiana Special ID, or some other generally recognized picture ID that contains your name and signature, you may still cast your vote by signature on a voter affidavit. You may obtain a free special ID card from the Louisiana Office of Motor Vehicles by showing your voter information card.

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

To vote in the upcoming Presidential election, make sure your mail-in registration form is postmarked by **October 11, 2016**.

REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Louisiana, you must be:

- a U.S. citizen
- a resident of Louisiana, and parish in which you seek to register
- at least 17 years old (18 to vote in election)

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, your voting rights are restored and you may register to vote when your terms of incarceration, probation and parole are complete. Visit www.geauxvote.com for more information about registering to vote.

EARLY VOTING DATES

Early voting dates for the general election are **Tuesday, October 25 - Tuesday, November 1, 2016**.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

All registered voters in Louisiana may request and mail in an absentee ballot only with an acceptable excuse, including being: aged 65 or over, a student in school away from parish, and unavailable due to travel or work. Visit www.geauxvote.com for a complete list.

- Must be requested by **4:30 pm on November 4, 2016** (four days before Election Day)
- Must be received by **4:30 pm on November 7, 2016** (the day before Election Day).
