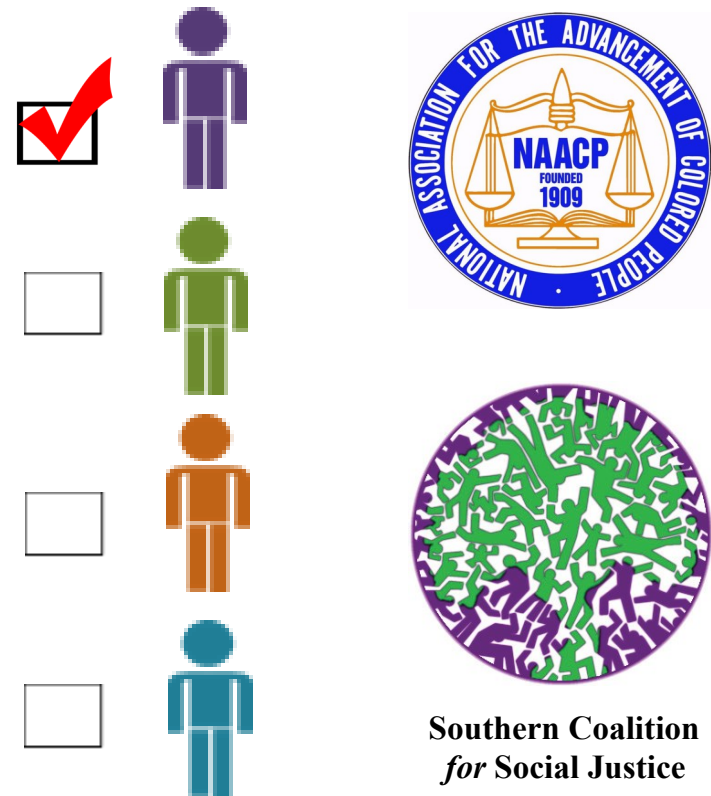
## VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

For the 2016 general election, a valid form of **identification (ID) is required**. Identification may include, but not limited to, any Current and Valid Photo ID:

- NJ driver's license, Military or other Government ID, Student or Job ID, Store Membership Card, United States Passport,
- Or
- Bank statement, Car registration, Government check or document, Non-photo NJ driver's license, Rent receipt, Sample Ballot, Utility bill, or any other official document.

# VOTER REGISTRATION

# EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

## REGISTRATION DEADLINE

You must be **registered by Tuesday, October 18, 2016** (at least 21 days prior to Election Day) to vote in the upcoming election.

There is neither same-day registration nor Election Day registration.

## REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in New Jersey, you must be:

- a U.S. citizen,
- a resident of a NJ county for 30 days before an election,
- at least 18 years old by the next general election.

If you have been **convicted of a felony**, you can complete a new voter registration form after the terms of incarceration, probation and parole are complete.

## EARLY VOTING

There is not a statewide early voting program.

## ABSENTEE BALLOTS

All registered New Jersey voters may request and mail an absentee ballot without an excuse.

- Must be **requested by Tuesday, November 1, 2016** (seven days before an election).
- Must be **requested by 3:00pm November 7, 2016** for in-person mail-in ballot applications.
- Must be **received by close of polls on Election Day** for mail-in ballots.
