## VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

In order to vote in Utah, **you need a valid identification (ID) that shows your name and photograph:** *UT driver license; ID card issued by the state or branch, department, or agency of the US; UT permit to carry a concealed weapon; US passport, or tribal ID card.*

**Or two forms of ID that show your name and address.**

Some examples include: *current utility bill, certified birth certificate, social security card, state or federal government check, US military ID card, Medicaid/Medicare, or Electronic Benefits Transfer card.*

# EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

## REGISTRATION DEADLINE

You must be **registered by Tuesday, October 11, 2016** if mailing a voter registration form, or **registered by Tuesday November 1, 2016** to register online, or at your county clerk's office.

There is neither same-day registration nor Election Day registration.

## REQUIREMENTS

To vote in Utah, a person must be:

- A United States citizen;
- At least 18 years old on the day of the election;
- A Utah resident in the precinct for at least 30 days preceding the election.

If you have **been convicted of a felony**, your voting rights are restored automatically after release from prison. You can vote while on probation or parole. Visit [vote.utah.gov/](http://vote.utah.gov/) for more details.

## EARLY VOTING DATES

Early voting dates are **Tuesday, October 25 - Friday, November 4, 2016**.

## EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS

Contact your local county board of elections by phone or visit them online for early voting locations

## ABSENTEE BALLOTS

All Utah voters may request and mail an absentee ballot without an excuse.

- Must be **requested by Thursday, November 3, 2016**
- Must be **received by close of polls on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, 2016**.
