VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

Wyoming **does not require photo ID for the purpose of voting**. However, if you registered by mail and are voting in a federal election for the first time, you must show photo ID or a document that has both your name and residence address.

VOTER REGISTRATION

EARLY & ABSENTEE VOTING

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

You must be registered by **Monday, October 24, 2016** to vote in the upcoming election. **On Election Day, you can register and vote** at your polling place with identification (ID) and proof of address.

REQUIREMENTS

To register to vote in Wyoming, you must be:

- a U.S. citizen,
- a resident of Wyoming and precinct in which you register,
- at least 18 years old on Election Day.

If you are **convicted of a felony**, you must wait five years after completing your sentence to apply for having voting rights restored. Visit **corrections.wy.gov/info-for-offenders/restoration** for more information about voting rights restoration.

EARLY VOTING DATES

Early voting dates for the general election are **Friday, September 23 - Monday, November 7, 2016**.

EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS

Contact your local county board of elections by phone or visit them online for early voting locations

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

All registered Wyoming voters may request and mail an absentee ballot without an excuse.

- Must be requested by **Monday, November 7, 2016** (one day before Election Day).
- Must be **received by 7:00 pm on Election Day**.
